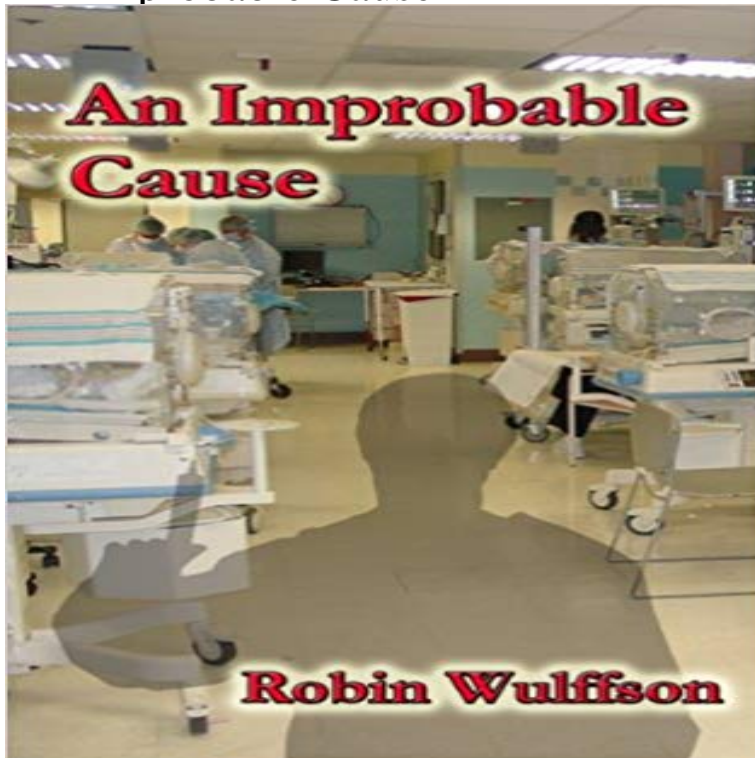


An Improbable Cause
