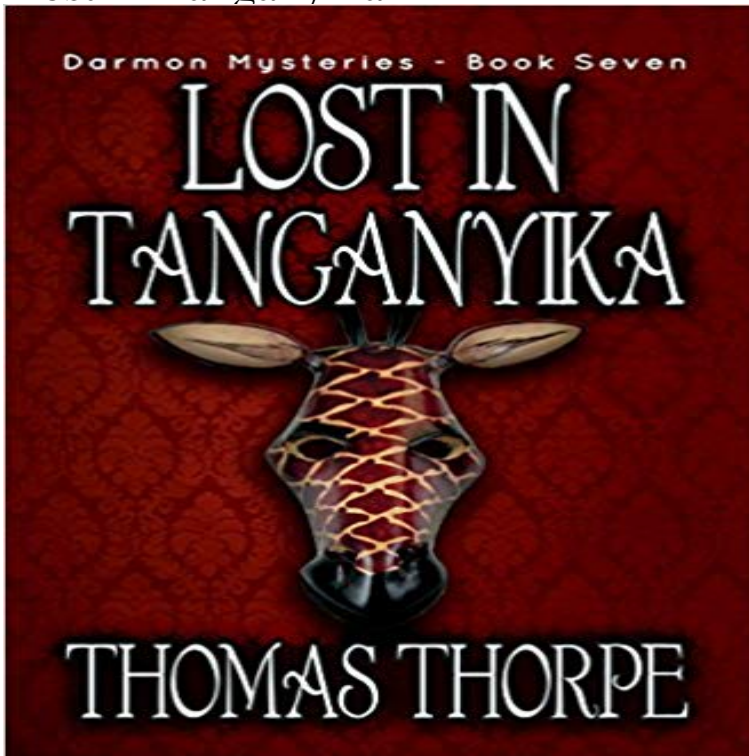


Lost in Tanganyika
