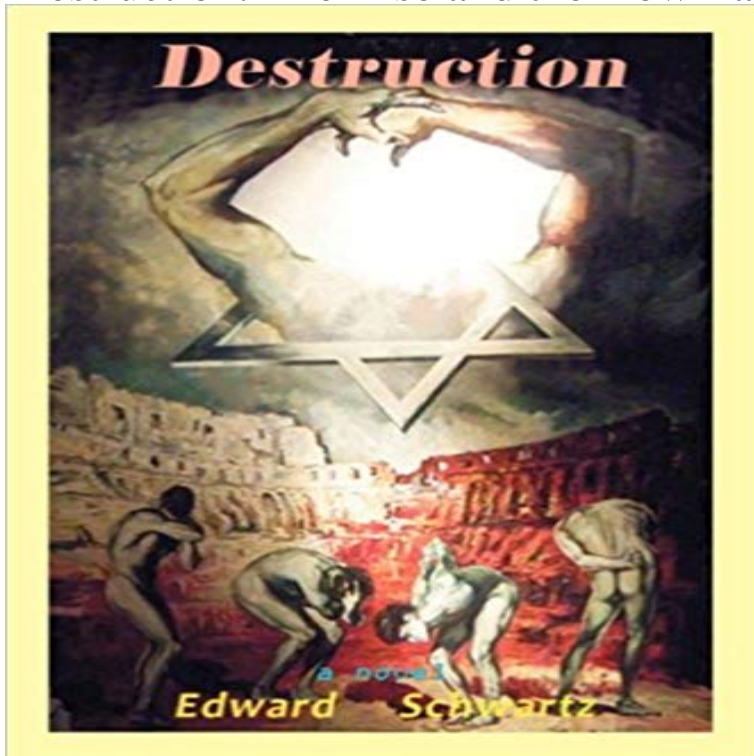


Destruction: The Rise and the Downfall of Joseph Flavius
