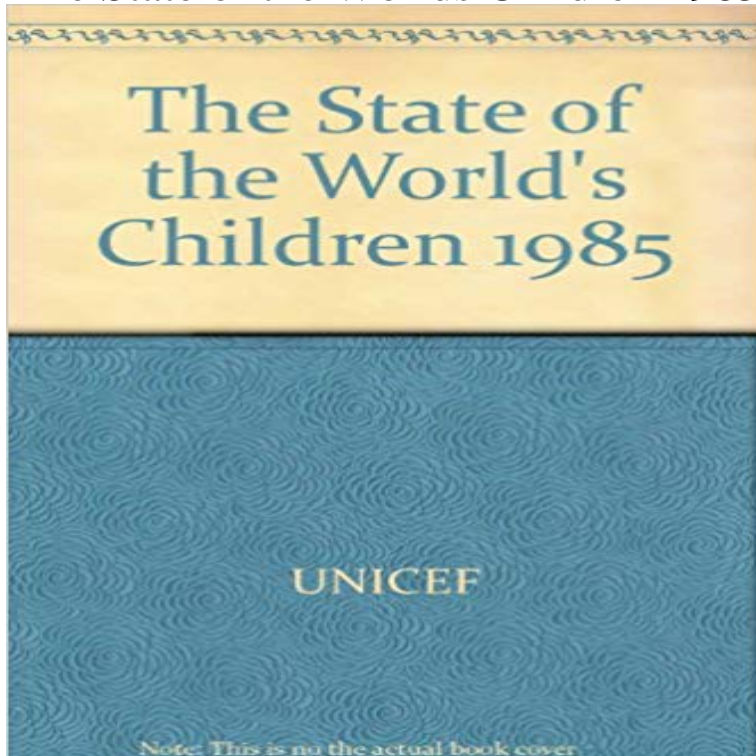


The State of the Worlds Children 1985



This annual report by UNICEF examines three key factors that determine whether a child will thrive and develop: access to food; access to basic health services; caring practices. It explores low-cost measures that can be taken to improve a child's quality of life, and puts forward a plan to alleviate some of the effects of childhood malnutrition.
